The first VI special course, "vascular damage control surgery", for the German Armed Forces showed its benefits after only a few weeks' time when a complex vascular arm injury was repaired in Masār-i Scharīf, Afghanistan by one of the course participants. The concept and success were so convincing that the VI course was integrated into the curriculum of the German armed forces and is now offered to NATO. The opportunity to practise complex procedures intensively in a safe environment before a stressful situation – be that in the field hospital of Masār-i Scharīf or at home – will be an integral part of future vascular training. I am aware that I am biased when I say these training courses are beneficial and sensible. I have participated in these courses as a trainee myself. Now I teach them because of my convictions that they are valuable. Through many positive feedbacks I was allowed to learn about the benefits first handed.

For many years now, I share this passion with all our tutors. However because of my partiality for these courses, I feel that it is especially important that several publications in [peer review journals](#) independently prove the positive impact of these vascular training courses. **At VASCULAR INTERNATIONAL, we are thrilled to offer special courses designed to meet your needs. 
