Complex Endovascular Aortic Repair (BREVAR, FEVAR)

This one-day interdisciplinary course is designed to teach practical skills in endovascular treatment of complex aortic pathologies. The attendees can practice endovascular techniques in small groups on dedicated virtual simulators. The main focus is lying on different techniques, devices and the decision making process. For the simulator training sessions experienced tutors are available. The course is aimed for advanced vascular surgeons.

Course Content

- To learn indications for treatment in complex aortic disease and the scientific evidence
- To learn endovascular materials and tools
- To learn the workflow of FEVAR and BREVAR in complex aortic disease
- To learn different techniques in special situations
- To learn complication management and follow-up of patients
- To practice on sizing software
- To practice on virtual training simulators
